Anatomy and Physiology (80 hours) - Covers the basics of human anatomy and physiology including anatomical terminology, basic biochemistry, cells and tissues, and the integumentary, skeletal, muscular, nervous, endo- crine, cardiovascular, lymphatic/immune, respiratory, digestive, urinary, and reproductive systems. Introduces common human disease processes. **Two locations to choose from. Choose only one. This course is a pre-requisite for entrance into the Practical Nursing program. Network Cabling—Copper (40 hours)- This course provides students with the knowledge and skills needed to become certified entry-level technicians in the Network Cabling industry. The course focuses on: (1) Proper tool use and construction techniques, (2) The character- istics of various industry standards; and (3) Troubleshooting and repair. Structural Steel Fabricator (48 hours)- The Structural Steel Fabricator course builds on the TCAT Welding course to help the student become a complete fabricator. In addition to welding, students will learn to safely handle heavy structural steel pieces, to use tools specific to the fabrication industry, fastening of assemblies with structural bolts, air carbon arc cutting and gouging and reading and interpretation of shop specific blueprints.
