- 4. When selecting the **Program of Study**, make sure to select the campus location you wish to attend, then click on the "None" down arrow for the specific Supplemental **Concentration** you wish to attend.
- 5. Select **Application is Complete** when you have completed the application. Select **Finish Later** if you would like to finish your application later.
- 6. Check your personal and TBR campus email regularly for correspondence from Admissions. You will be notified via your campus email to con- firm your acceptance. Upon confirming your acceptance, applicants will be administratively registered until the course is filled.

Anatomy and Physiology (80 hours) - Covers the basics of hu- man anatomy and physiology including anatomical terminology, basic biochemistry, cells and tissues, and the integumentary, skele- tal, muscular, nervous, endocrine, cardiovascular, lymphatic/ immune, respiratory, digestive, urinary, and reproductive systems.
