Entrepreneur and Small Business Training (27 Hours) **** Choose only one location. This course is a 9 week cohort-based program that equips entrepreneurs and potential entrepreneurs of all kinds with the insights, relationships, and tools needed to turn ideas into action. Drawing from the experience of entrepreneurs and startup thought-leaders, the course walks small-business owners or potential small-business owners through the lean business modeling methods used by high-growth startups, in a simple and intuitive way. In addition to exploring different topics each session, guest speakers are also brought in to enrich the conversation and help participants learn from the experience of others in the community. During the program, participants develop and fine-tune their ideas, critically examining every part and determining next steps through real-time feedback. Topics include knowing yourself, knowing your customer, marketing, building the model to scale, strengthening your structure, discovering your bottom line, accounting, and planning for the future. The course culminates with a pitch night and celebration of accomplishments. The outcome goals for participants are a deeper understanding of how to create a sustainable business (a process for figuring out whether or not an idea is good and how to change it to make it work), the ability to articulate how their businesses work, the next steps needed to move forward, and a community of peers, mentors, business services, and a network of support.
