<p>Anatomy and Physiology (80 hours) - Covers the basics of human anatomy and physiology including anatomical terminology, basic biochemistry, cells and tissues, and the integumentary, skeletal, muscular, nervous, endocrine, cardiovascular, lymphatic/immune, respiratory, digestive, urinary, and reproductive systems. <p>Math for Meds (40 hours) - Beginning with a review of basic mathematical principles, the course then progresses through drug dosage calculations, ratio and proportion, and medication safety. Common drug measures will be discussed and medication labels reviewed.</p> <p>Student is required to have a TI 30XA Calculator.</p> <p>* Class will be held at the Shelbyville Campus.</p> <p>This course is now a pre-requisite for entrance into the Practical Nursing program. <p>Certified Logistics Associate (CLA) (42 hours)- The course provides students with the foundational broad knowledge they will need to understand the world of supply chain and related core competencies. Learning materials include PDF textbook and e-learning modules. The Course includes modules on: the global supply chain, the logistics environment, safety, safe equipment operation, material handling equipment, quality control, workplace communication, teamwork and problem solving and using computers. The course focuses on: (1) Proper tool use and construction techniques, (2) The characteristics of various industry standards; and (3) Troubleshooting and repair.
